DAVID M. TEITELBAUM

award-winning developer, created the nation's first real estate recycling consortium, packaged the first large-scale conversion of offices into apartments, and financed real estate projects with international funds. He is currently developing residential, commercial, recreational and cultural projects in excess of \$100 million in New York City.



President of Teitelbaum Holdings, Ltd., he is also chairman of the Adaptive Re-use Committee of the Real Estate Board of New York, advisory member to New York City's Housing Preservation and Development Department, board member of the Citizens Housing and Planning Council of New York, and adjunct assistant professor of New York University's Real Estate Institute.
